- ✓ The Interactive Program of Study (iPOS) must be filed when you have registered for or completed 50% of your coursework.
- ✓ You must maintain a 3.0 GPA in your iPOS Coursework, Graduate Coursework GPA, and Cumulative Graduate GPA.
- ✓ JHR 549 must be taken in your last semester of study. All coursework must be completed prior to registration.
- All coursework must be completed within 6 years of the first course that appears on your iPOS.
