

FLAGSHIP @ ASU - Fall 2022







We are seeking highly motivated people to be part of a unique, project-based learning experience. The Future Leaders and Geoscience High-Road Internship Program (FLAGSHIP) at Arizona State University is a paid, experiential learning, careers pathways program. This program is funded in part by the National Science Foundation and is a collaboration between Arizona State University and the American Geophysical Union.

The FLAGSHIP program seeks to involve students from groups historically underrepresented in the sciences, including Black or African American, American Indian or Alaska Native, Hispanic or Latino, female, first-generation college students, veterans, and students with disabilities. FLAGSHIP welcomes lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender students; students who have experienced, and worked to overcome, educational or economic disadvantages that may complicate their continued progress in academic or research careers.

You will "earn as you learn" about the wide range of careers in critical infrastructure protecting your community against climate change and sea level rise impacts. Selected interns will learn about these careers and career pathways through guided research, mentoring, and network building with practicing professionals.

From October 10, 2022, through December 16, 2022, interns will:

- Learn about infrastructure protecting communities against climate and sea level rise impacts, and the careers and salaries of the people who build, maintain, and operate these systems
- Study (via Zoom) local projects, develop technical and career pathways presentations during eight weeks' training
- Meet and collaborate on projects with practicing professionals (think: potential employers!)
- Participate in-person in the largest worldwide annual gathering of earth and atmospheric scientists, the American Geophysical Union's Fall Meeting (December 11 to 16) in Chicago, Illinois.

Submit your application by September 15, 2022 (Thursday), to be considered for this incredible program! Successful applicants will be notified by email and will need to confirm your acceptance of this offer in writing to Arizona State University no later than September 21, 2022 (Wednesday), or you cannot participate in the program.

Here are the requirements for acceptance and to receive the full travel and internship stipend:

- You must be 18 years old as of your application date
- Complete your application thoughtfully, completely and on time (due September 15, 2022)
- Have access to a computer and internet service for meetings and project work
- Be willing to work as a team to develop high quality technical and career presentations
- Attend twice weekly evening/late afternoon meetings via Zoom from October 3 to December 16
- Have a commitment to complete the full program to receive the full stipend, travel, and daily cost allowance
- Dedicate the week of December 11-16, 2022, to participate in person and give presentations at the American Geophysical Union's Annual Meeting (~25,000 attendees) in Chicago, Illinois
- Following the AGU Fall meeting, participate in a four-week (via Zoom) Mentoring program during January-February 2023 where you will learn about exciting summer internships and how/when to apply for them
- Provide proof of full COVID vaccination prior to arrival at conference.
