SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

The Ed and Judy Lynn Scholarship will provide financial assistance to a deserving **graduate student enrolled in the Masters of Arts in Communication Studies (MACS) program**. Lynn Scholars should embrace the values of Ed Lynn, which include a lifelong ethic of hard work, leadership, personal accountability, and a commitment to helping others develop their potential. In addition, they will show evidence of academic excellence, persistence, and a strong likelihood of success in the MACS program.

- The scholarship is primarily aimed at supporting students with a promising academic record established as *undergraduates* seeking admission to the MACs program who embody the key values of the Lynn Scholars noted above.
- Recipients of the scholarship must demonstrate that they are personally covering a portion of the costs of attendance – that they have some “skin in the game”. Recipients should demonstrate that they have financial need.
- Lynn Scholars are engaged academic leaders. They are expected to work closely with a MACS faculty mentor on projects related to teaching, research, or community service. This commitment normally involves roughly ten hours of engagement per week during the spring and fall semesters.
- While applications from undergraduates from ASU's West Campus with a BA/BS in Communication are especially encouraged, previous Lynn Scholars have diverse backgrounds and academic histories.
