What counts as an elective course?

What counts:

Regularly scheduled 500-level MAS courses taught by MA program faculty

What needs to be approved (in advance) by both the student's faculty advisor & the graduate program director:

- Individualized MAS courses (e.g., 580, 584, 590, 592)
- 400-level courses in any discipline
- Courses transferred in from other universities

What does not count:

- 585 or 595 credit
- 100, 200, or 300-level courses

Faculty approval required for:

 up to 6 credit hours of 400-level work applying toward the master's degree.

General Guidelines

- up to 9 credit hours of individualized instruction (any combination of (590, 592, 580, 584, etc.) applying toward the master's degree.
- up to 3 credit hours of individualized instruction with a faculty member outside of NCIAS.
- All coursework in the interactive Plan of Study (iPOS). Mere enrollment in a course does not entitle a student to count it toward a graduate degree.

Academic progress:

- Students are required to meet <u>New College Satisfactory</u>
 <u>Academic Progress Standards</u> and maintain continuous
 enrollment as defined by the <u>ASU Graduate College Policy</u>
 <u>Manual.</u>
- The culminating experience is completed in a student's final year of study. To be eligible for registration consult the program handbook.
- Students must earn a B or better in the MAS 585 culminating experience, for additional information go to New College Satisfactory Academic Progress Standards.

Policies:

- Core courses can never be transferred from other universities.
- All work toward a master's degree must be completed within six consecutive years. For more information review the <u>ASU</u> <u>Graduate College Policy Manual</u>.
